OPEN AND YOUTH BOER GOAT WINNERS AWARDED AT RODEO AUSTIN

AUSTIN, Texas – Rodeo Austin kicked off the livestock show on Sunday, with the Open and Youth Boer Goats classes. Quentin Foster exhibited the Champion Doe in the Open Youth Percentage Blood Boer Goat show on March 12, 2006. Carson Washington earned Reserve Champion Doe honors.

Lucinda A. Birkenfeld exhibited the Champion Buck in the Youth Open Fullblood Boer Goat show. Trapper Lewis was awarded Reserve Champion Buck. Birkenfeld also exhibited the Champion Doe and Quentin Foster exhibited the Reserve Champion Doe in the Fullblood Boer Goat show.

Tomorrow at Rodeo Austin, look for the AQHA Youth Horse Show starting at 9 am and the Junior Market Roasters show at 3 pm.
