

How To Apply For Rodeo Austin Scholarships

Rodeo Austin awards scholarships to deserving students each year through partnering educational institutions. Scholarship Recipients are selected based on financial need, academic achievement and community involvement. Rodeo Austin establishes the selection criteria, then the partnering educational institutions make the specific student selections each year.

To be considered for a Rodeo Austin Scholarship, you must be attending one of the partnering colleges or universities or have participated in 4-H or FFA programs. Below are general instructions for how to apply for Rodeo Austin Scholarships at each institution. Please contact each institution's financial aid department for specific questions on the application process.

Partnering Educational Institutions:

Austin Community College

Deadline is May 1. Open to incoming freshman who are pursuing a degree in any college/major.

Any student who applies for admission to St. Edward's University and is admitted as an incoming freshman for the fall semester, will automatically be considered for a Rodeo Austin scholarship.

Deadline is December 15. Open to incoming freshman who are pursuing a degree in the Emmett & Miriam McCoy College of Business Administration only.
